Education & Training

Our nonprofit frequently participates in panel discussions, presentations and documentary showings focused on suicide and brain health, with the goal of creating a more understanding, empathic community for those at risk. We also lead trainings in QPR (Question, Persuade, Refer), an evidence-based gatekeeper training for suicide prevention.



Hope Squad

We offer support, funding and oversight to schools for Hope Squad, a peer-to-peer, evidence-based, suicide prevention program that reduces youth suicide risk through education, training and peer intervention.

Peer Grief Support

Sharing Kindness offers free peer grief support programs for specific age groups, relationships and types of loss, which are led by trained clinicians and volunteer co-facilitators. Funds from this event benefit our suicide-specific grief programs, including those for suicide loss survivors and suicide attempt survivors, with separate groups for the families/friends of attempt survivors.
