The 2026 Sharing Kindness Suicide Awareness Walk is on Saturday, May 16th at Veterans Park Beach in Hyannis.

The rate of suicide deaths on the Cape & Islands is among the highest in Massachusetts. Each year, we gather to remember those who have died by suicide, support those who are struggling, and raise awareness of the issues facing our community (last year, a record-breaking 600+ walkers joined us!).

About Us

In 2016, Jeremy Walters, a junior at Nauset Regional High School, died by suicide. In the wake of his death, Jeremy’s family struggled to find local resources for youth suicide and grief support. Determined to honor Jeremy’s life, Kim Mead-Walters, MD, and Davis Walters founded Sharing Kindness as a 501(c)(3) nonprofit in 2018 with the goal of supporting youth mental health and people grieving all types of loss, including suicide.

People who experience mental health challenges, grief, and suicide loss often feel alone due to a lack of understanding and pervasive stigma surrounding these issues. We’re working to change that. Sharing Kindness provides a wide range of programs to reduce suicide risk, support those who struggle, companion the bereaved and nurture health and wellness in our community.

Vision

Our goal is to open a space of our very own, called The Healing House, which will be a central “hub” for our programming, community events and more.



Mission

Sharing Kindness is building a grief-sensitive, suicide-aware Cape & Islands community.

Your Donation's Impact

Education & Training

Our nonprofit frequently provides panel discussions, presentations and documentary showings focused on suicide and brain health, including our own presentation series called Grief 101. We also lead trainings in QPR (Question, Persuade, Refer), an evidence-based gatekeeper training for suicide prevention.

Hope Squad

We offer support, funding and oversight to schools for Hope Squad, a peer-to-peer, evidence-based suicide prevention program that reduces youth suicide risk through education, training and peer intervention.

Peer Grief Support

Sharing Kindness offers free peer grief support programs for specific age groups, relationships and types of loss, which are led by trained clinicians and volunteer co-facilitators. Funds from this event benefit our suicide-specific grief programs, including those for suicide loss survivors.

By the Numbers:

- ▶ Approximately **200** community members trained in QPR in the past year
- ▶ **12** high schools and **2** middle schools with Hope Squads on the Cape and Martha's Vineyard (with more to come!)
- ▶ **62** suicide loss survivors from the Cape and Islands served through peer grief support groups
